The Championship's only double-fixture weekend of the season saw Gould-NME driver Martin Groves start to strengthen his grip on the series with another pair of run-off wins at Barbon Manor's high speed Lakeland dash. But he was denied a third successive double at Harewood's sinuous Stockton Farm course the next day by first time British winner Karl Davison, who defeated Groves in the opening run-off. The series leader retaliated with another run-off victory in the afternoon, chased home by Roger Moran who took charge of second overall in the series as he edged ahead of opening round winner Willem Toet. Second and third place finishes during the weekend kept a revitalised Simon Durling well in touch with fourth in the points table, with Groves' co-driver Paul Ranson hanging on to fifth. Tied for sixth currently are Rob Turnbull's potent Gould-HB V8 and the giant-killing two-litre OMS of Harewood class record-breaker Trevor Willis.
